

FBe Pedigree Request

1. Mating

- If you live in Flanders, ensure that the combination of parents meets the inbreeding requirements of the Flemish Breeding Decree. (See Breed Sheet Flemish Breeding Decree.)
- If you live in Flanders ensure that the kittens of the chosen combination do not have a COI 1% higher than the average COI of both parents. (See Breed Sheet Flemish Breeding Decree.)
- Provide the pedigree secretariat with a health declaration for both parents (Form FBE Annex 5 health certificate) in accordance with paragraph 1982 of the Belgian Kennel Decree.
- If you live in Flanders, have a DNA profile drawn up for both parents. (See guide DNA Profiles)
- If you live in Flanders, ensure that both parents at least meet the mandatory performance tests of the breed. (See Breed Sheet Flemish Breeding Decree)
- Make sure that both parents at least comply with Appendix I and II of the FIFe Breeding & Registration Rules

2. Birth Declaration of the Litter

- Within 8 days after birth by e-mail to the studbook secretariat or via the member portal with notification of the number of kittens. <u>Member Portal</u>
- Mating form if applicable. (FBE-Annex-2-EN-Matingform)

3. Pedigree Request Kittens

- Within 100 days after birth.
- Chip number
- Parentage analysis if the kittens were born in Flanders. (See Guide DNA Profiles)
 - o Individual per kitten
 - o Per litter
